- Please leave dogs at home.
- Appropriate footwear and approved Head Gear is mandatory. All riders must
 wear proper fitting, approved protective head gear, with the safety harness
 correctly secured at all times while mounted in competition or on event grounds.
 Approved head gear must meet the ASTM standards and displays the SEI seal.
 The British standard, BSI is also acceptable.
