Class Eligibility:

Pre-Novice: open to riders, who can only cross enter into novice. Recommended for riders in their first year of showing.

Green Hunter: open to all horses and ponies in their first or second year showing.

Pony Hunter: open to all ponies.

Novice Rider: open to riders who have not won three first over fences in a recognized show.

Child Adult: open to horses and ponies ridden by amateur or child.

Trot Pole Course: open to riders who have never jumped.

Green Glen Rules and Regulations:

- **Commonly accepted practices in each discipline will govern. Please ask horse show management if you have any questions.**
- A refund of entry costs will be provided upon presentation of a vet certificate.
- Boots are permitted, bandages are not permitted.
- Bitless bridles are not allowed.
- A crop or whip is not to be used more than three times for any one incident.
- Second cumulative refusal, run out or bolting on course results in elimination.
- **In the event that a rider falls off they may not remount in the ring**
- All riders are responsible for showing proof of minimum, two million dollars liability insurance. eg: 2011 Ontario Equestrian Federation Membership; Individual household liability insurance. No other memberships necessary!
- **Entries must be received by 6pm on the Wednesday prior to the show date.**
- **Please leave dogs at home.**
- **Appropriate footwear and approved Head Gear is mandatory. All riders must wear proper fitting, approved protective head gear, with the safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted in competition or on event grounds. Approved head gear must meet the ASTM standards and displays the SEI seal. The British standard, BSI is also acceptable.**
